1. We will adore God... (WORSHIP)

John 4:23 Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers **will worship** the Father in the Spirit and in truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks.

Rev 14:6-7 Then I saw another angel flying in midair, and he had the eternal gospel to proclaim to those who live on the earth—to every nation, tribe, language and people. He said in a loud voice, "Fear God and give him glory, because the hour of his judgment has come. **Worship him** who made the heavens, the earth, the sea and the springs of water."

Rev 4:10-11 the twenty-four elders fall down before him who sits on the throne and **worship him** who lives for ever and ever. They lay their crowns before the throne and say: "You are worthy, our Lord and God, **to receive glory and honor and power**, for you created all things, and by your will they were created and have their being."

Rev 15:2-3 And I saw what looked like a sea of glass glowing with fire and, standing beside the sea, those who had been victorious over the beast and its image and over the number of its name. They held harps given them by God and **sang** the song of God's servant Moses and of the Lamb: "Great and marvelous are your deeds, Lord God Almighty. Just and true are your ways, King of the nations.

But not worship by going to a "church service"

Revelation 21:22 there will be **no temple**, because the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are its temple

2. Reign with Christ (AUTHORITY)

Revelation 22:5 "They will reign for ever and ever"

Dan 7:27 Then the sovereignty, power and greatness of all the kingdoms under heaven **will be handed over** to the holy people of the Most High. His kingdom will be an everlasting kingdom, and all rulers will worship and obey him.'

Matthew 19:28-30 Jesus said to them, "Truly I tell you, at the renewal of all things, when the Son of Man sits on his glorious throne, you who have followed me will also sit on twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel. And everyone who has left houses or brothers or sisters or father or mother or wife or children or fields for my sake will receive a hundred times as much and will inherit eternal life. But many who are first will be last, and many who are last will be first.

3. We will serve God and each other (WORK)

Daniel prophesied that the Messiah would be *"given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve him"* Daniel 7:14

Rev 7:15 Therefore, "they are before the throne of God and **serve** him day and night in his temple; and he who sits on the throne will shelter them with his presence.

Rev. 22:3 No longer will there be any curse. The throne of God and of the Lamb will be in the city, and his servants will **serve** him.

4. Eat and drink (FELLOWSHIP)

Luke 22:29-30 Jesus said to his disciples, "I confer on you a kingdom, just as my Father conferred one on me, so that you may **eat and drink** at my table in my kingdom."

Luke 14:15-23 Parable of the Great Banquet

Is 25:6 On this mountain the LORD Almighty will prepare a **feast** of rich food for all peoples, a banquet of aged wine— the best of meats and the finest of wines.

Rev 19:9 Then the angel said to me, "Write this: Blessed are those who are invited to the **wedding supper** of the Lamb!" And he added, "These are the true words of God."

Rev. 21:6 He said to me: "It is done. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. To the thirsty I will give **water** without cost from the spring of the water of life.

Rev 22:1-2 Then the angel showed me the river of the water of life, as clear as crystal, flowing from the throne of God and of the Lamb down the middle of the great street of the city. On each side of the river stood the tree of life, bearing twelve **crops of fruit**, yielding its fruit every month.

5. Read and study God's word... learn (GROW/CHANGE)

Psalm 119:89 Your word, LORD, is eternal; it stands firm in the heavens.

Mt 24:35 Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away.

Ephesians 2:6-7 "God raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus, in order that in the coming ages he might show the incomparable riches of his grace."

The word show means "to reveal." There will be a progressive, ongoing revelation, in which we learn more and more about God's grace.

1 Cor 13:12 For now we see only a reflection as in a mirror; then we shall see face to face. Now I know in part; then I shall know fully, even as I am fully known.
