

During a year full of risk and uncertainty, through your faithful stewardship and generosity, we were able to maintain sound financial health.

Even more important, we were able to reach people outside our church family with the love of Jesus.

In 2020, your tithes and offerings provided \$14,994.48 in benevolence money!
